As part of the Alumni Mentorship Programme, we are inviting mentors to apply. This program aims to depict the existence of a perpetual symbiotic relationship. The AMP 3.0 program is designed for the second-year students of FIIB on a voluntary basis for the purpose of creating meaningful relationships between alumni, students, and the institute. The program will begin in August 2022 and last until November 2022.

What to be a mentor ? The following are the prerequisites:

- Have a minimum of three years work experience

Alumni Mentor Guidelines:

- Give constructive, supportive feedback on the students' work, plans, and achievements.
- Assist the mentee in clarifying doubts, seeking advice and asking questions on a range of topics (including career-related opportunities and live projects).
- Connect students with other mentors and/or industry contacts who share complementary interests in order to foster networks and multiple informal mentors.
- Consider the interests of your mentees by providing them with opportunities to demonstrate their competencies (specific training interventions).
